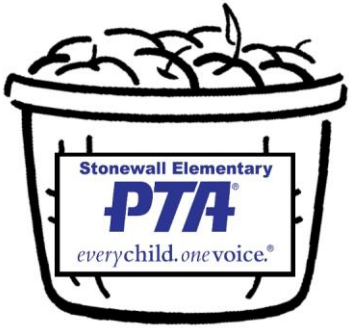

MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

PROGRAMS/SCHOOL EVENTS

Art Fair
Coordinator needed. Volunteers needed to coordinate vendors, hang artwork around the school and in your child's classroom, setup, cleanup, etc. This event is planned for February.

Champs Skate Night

Volunteers needed to help plan and coordinate a date for this event, as well as to be present that night. This event takes place in October.

Entrepreneur Fair/Pizza Supper

Help serve pizza, setup, clean up, etc. This event normally takes place in March.

Field Day

Occurs in May each year and is a school-wide event. Coordinator needed. In addition, many volunteers are needed in multiple areas such as setting up games, helping to run the games, serving popcorn and other areas as needed.

Food Drives/Clothing Drives

Organizing, publicizing, and collecting food and clothing during drives. These service projects take place in November and December.

Gabbin' with Gatliff

Coordinator needed. Assist with planning, setup and clean up. These informational events, presented by Mr. Gatliff, take place in the Fall and Spring.

PROGRAMS/SCHOOL EVENTS (CONTINUED)

Kentucky Kids Day

Assist in planning and volunteering for activities during the school day. One-day event held in September to celebrate and honor our kids.

Family Movie Night

Volunteers needed to help with planning, as well as to work the night of the event serving popcorn and drinks. This event normally takes place in November.

Reading Night

Volunteers are needed to help on the evening of this school event. This event takes place in October.

Science Night

Coordinator needed. Other volunteers needed to help with setup, serve pizza and drinks. This event will take place in April, just before Spring testing.

WinterFest

Coordinator needed for pre-event planning and to work the day of the festival. Other volunteers are needed work the day of the festival. Sell tickets, serve food, work games, work dunking booth, set up and clean up. Event is normally held one Saturday in February.

HEALTH/WELLNESS & SAFETY COMMITTEE

Walk to School Week

Assist walkers in signing in before school, serve juice or breakfast to walkers, donate items such as juice, muffins, fruit, etc. Mornings for one week during the Fall.

Wellness Programs, e.g. Wellness Night, YMCA Night.

Assist in planning and coordinating health and wellness activities during PTA Healthy Lifestyles Month (November), as well as setup and cleanup.

Red Ribbon Week

This event happens in October. Volunteering would involve working with the school counselor to plan and carry out activities during the week devoted to drug awareness.

HOSPITALITY COMMITTEE

Teacher and Staff Appreciation

Set up for teacher luncheons and bring cooked items to school for special events. This is a year-round committee with specific events each month.

FUNDRAISING

Help with promotion of fundraising events, collection of order forms, and distribution of items sold from fundraisers.

Easy money! All you have to do is shop at Kroger and swipe the card! No additional fees are required. The Kroger gift card is very easy to use. Just purchase a card through the Stonewall PTA for \$5.00. Your new gift card is already loaded with your \$5.00 purchase price. Anytime you shop at Kroger, use this card to pay for your purchases. You may recharge your gift card at any register or at the service desk **before** the cashier scans your order. Kroger cards can be recharged with cash, check or charge. They can be recharged in any amount up to \$200.00. They can be used at any Kroger, anywhere! Kroger gift cards make great gifts because they can be used for so many things. They can be used to purchase food, medicine and gasoline. The new Marketplace Kroger offers house wares, furniture and jewelry. Stonewall supporters have purchased Kroger cards to give as teacher appreciation gifts, gifts for babysitters and one business even purchased them for holiday gifts for their whole staff.
