Minutes

Call Meeting to Order – Everyone signed in, Jennifer Crocket called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m. in the school library.

President's Welcome

Principal's Report - Mr. Gatliff reported that the renovation plans are being finalized. We will have complexes instead of portables. 2nd and 3rd grades will be in the portables. Renovations will start in June, will take 2 years.

K-1st and 2nd grade report cards will be delayed because they are getting new report cards.

Reading and approval of minutes - Correction - add fundraiser star under PTA 5K, Robyn Johnson approved minutes, Amelia Confides second.

Treasurer's Report (Amelia Confides) - \$17,666.49 was made from the Bumblebee Fundraiser we will get 45% of this. The current balance is \$43, 486.98, 55% is going to pay Bumblebee. Everything went well with Sonic Night, getting bills paid. Approved the SAP committee, \$700 request for Stretch and Grow program for all of kindergarten classes. Also approved \$153 for mobile science lab for all of third grade.

- **Healthy Lifestyles** – PTA 5K, Wellness Night, Healthy Lifestyles Month (Sarah-Ashley Solie) - PTA 5K, 70 people signed up, Jay McCord offered \$1,000 bonus to school with the most registrations, waiting on results. Nov. 3rd Wellness night from 6-8. Applied for the PTA Healthy lifestyle grant for \$1,000, waiting to see if we will receive it. November is healthy lifestyle month, Wellness Night will be the kick off. Each kid that turns in their tracking form will get a little gift.
